## DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

Section 1. The President shall preside at all meetings and shall perform the usual duties and exercise the usual powers of a presiding officer. The President shall appoint all committees and have the power to remove a member of any committee as deemed necessary for the best interest of the club. The President shall have the power to cast the deciding vote in case of a tie.

Section 2. The Vice President shall have all the powers and perform all of the duties in the absence of, resignation of, or removal of the President.

Section 3. The Secretary shall keep the records of the club, and conduct all official correspondence. The Secretary shall take notes of all proceedings and keep true records of all business transacted at each meeting.

Section 4. The Treasurer shall receive all monies and pay all bills properly approved by the club, keep a true and complete record of all receipts and expenditures, and keep a complete and accurate record of all club bank accounts and other club financial holdings.

Section 5. The Web Admin shall have the responsibility of overseeing the club website.
